Highlights of the 2025 deployment include more Bora Bora – an enduring favorite featured on most itineraries, nearly all with an overnight stay. Several itineraries feature overnights in Moorea, and nearly every cruise includes a visit to the line's private islet, Motu Mahana off the coast of Taha'a. Beyond the deep exploration of these Society Islands destinations, itineraries navigate the treasures of the Cook Islands, the Marquesas, and Tuamotus. Also included are rare visits to the Kingdom of Tonga and the blissful isles of Fiji.

All voyages travel round-trip from Papeete, Tahiti, except for two 14-night itineraries cruising between Papeete and Lautoka, Fiji. *The Gauguin's* 2025 itineraries include:
